- 1. Sale Times- Sales will be open for bidding at Noon EDT and close at 8:00 EDT on the days listed above.
- Sale Management- These Sales will be managed by Select Livestock Services. We have hired Breeders World Online Sales as the Online platform we will be using. All commissions and fees will be deducted by Select Livestock Services and all settlement checks will be issued by Select Livestock Services.
- 3. Why Breeders World?- Breeders World was contracted to provide the live broadcast with online bidding of all Ohio Showcase live Sales and they have access to our catalog information. Their professional platform and willingness to work with us under these difficult circumstances made them the logical choice.
- 4. Entry Fees and Commission- Your paid entry fee to Select Livestock Services will get your entries into the Online Sale. Commission charged by Select Livestock Services will be a maximum of 8%. The commission may be lowered depending on the amount of participation in these Sales. Breed Assn. sponsorships and Ohio Sheep & Wool checkoff monies will be deducted as was stated in the live auction rules.
- 5. **Minimum Bid** The minimum bid for all entries will be \$300 as was stated for the Ohio Showcase live sale. If you would like a higher minimum, you must let Breeders World know at the time you submit your information.
- 6. ONLINE ENTRY DEADLINE: 10 days prior to your breed sale date. EX. April 25 for the May 5 Sales, April 26 for the May 6 Sales etc.
- 7. Pedigree Info- All pedigree information must be submitted to Breeders World by these dates. See the contact information below. You can use the Ohio Showcase catalog Lot Numbers for reference, you have been emailed a copy of your breed catalog or you can print it off the Select Livestock Services web site. If your entry is as cataloged, just provide the Lot Number. If your entry is "Information Sale Day" or a substitution, provide all of the needed pedigree information.
- IMPORTANT!- *Please email or call Gary Saylor or Pat Myers with your number of Online entries and which Lot numbers by Wed., April 22. Email addresses and phone numbers are below. Added Entries- If you have additional entries to consign to the Online Sales, let Gary or Pat know. We will assign you Lot Numbers.
- 9. Pictures and/or videos- Again, pictures are due on the same date as the pedigree information. You should provide at least one picture and you may provide as many as you would like. We suggest a profile, rear view and a head shot. Sire and dam pictures are also fine. Please label all pictures to match to respective Lot Number. Videos are accepted as long as they are You Tube or Vimeo videos, you can just send Breeders World the link. *They must have the link to save time in uploading videos. NOTE: Good, quality pictures and presentation of the animal is vital in an online auction. Take a little time and shine them up a bit. They don't need to be show ring ready but well fitted sheep will always command a higher price. At least have them, sheared, patch sheared, cut out etc.

- **10. Transportation** As with all online sales, transportation needs to be arranged by communication amongst the Buyer and Seller. We can assist as we are hearing of trucks and trailers moving about the country.
- 11. Health Papers- Again, this requires communication amongst the Buyer and Seller. Some out of state buyers may request health papers and you as a consignor should provide.
- 12. Futurity Ewe Lambs- Most breeds have a Futurity program and all rules are different. It is your responsibility to adhere to the Futurity guidelines for your specific breed. Please designate which ewe lambs are Futurity nominated when you submit your entry information.

Note: Shropshires require a headshot with the scrapie tag number legible on all Futurity ewe lambs.

13. What if you Don't want to consign to the Online Sales? First, legally, we are not required to return entry fees. However, if there is good participation in the Online Sales, we will send you a full refund of your entry money. If there is light participation, we may retain a small portion of the entry fee, possibly \$5 per entry. We just want to cover the presale advertising expense incurred promoting this sale and your entries.
